**1 Sam. 2:2, “There is none holy as the LORD: for there is none beside You: neither is there a rock like our God.”**

The Hebrew word for *holy* is **ka do vsh** which means *sacred, set apart and the Holy One*.

Today’s scripture reminds us of the holiness of our God. There is none as holy as the LORD. In fact, **Isa. 6:1-4** shows a glimpse of His holiness through the eyes of Isaiah himself: **“In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord, high and exalted, seated on a throne; and the train of His robe filled the temple. 2 Above Him were seraphim, each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying. 3 And they were calling to one another: “Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is full of His glory.” 4 At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke.”**

God is three times holy. In other words, there is no one as holy as He is. He is set apart. His name is sacred. He is *the* Holy One. When we think of our Heavenly Father, we can know that He is and will always be Holy. Meditate on the words of this old hymn:

Holy, Holy, Holy! LORD God Almighty  
Early in the morning, our song shall rise to Thee  
Holy, Holy, Holy! Merciful and Mighty  
God in three persons, Blessed Trinity - *John B. Dykes*

**Dear Holy LORD, we praise You that You alone are holy. You are set apart and the Holy One. We worship You our Holy God. In Jesus Name, Amen**
