1 Sam. 2:2, "There is none <u>holy</u> as the LORD: for there is none beside You: neither is there a rock like our God."

The Hebrew word for holy is **ka do vsh** which means sacred, set apart and the Holy One. Today's scripture reminds us of the holiness of our God. There is <u>none</u> as holy as the LORD. In fact, **Isa. 6:1-4** shows a glimpse of His holiness through the eyes of Isaiah himself: "In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord, high and exalted, seated on a throne; and the train of His robe filled the temple. 2 Above Him were seraphim, each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying. 3 And they were calling to one another: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is full of His glory." 4 At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke."

God is three times holy. In other words, there is no one as holy as He is. He is set apart. His name is sacred. He is *the* Holy One. When we think of our Heavenly Father, we can know that He is and will always be Holy. Meditate on the words of this old hymn:

Holy, Holy, Holy! LORD God Almighty Early in the morning, our song shall rise to Thee Holy, Holy, Holy! Merciful and Mighty God in three persons, Blessed Trinity - *John B. Dykes*

Dear Holy LORD, we praise You that You alone are holy. You are set apart and the Holy One. We worship You our Holy God. In Jesus Name, Amen
