Ps. 33:12, "Blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD, the people He chose for His inheritance."

Now let me just begin with a defining statement. Obviously, the psalmist is speaking of Israel in this verse, but it is not only for Israel. This is a blessing that will reach to each and every nation that will choose to follow the LORD. Case in point? The United States of America. Founded and based upon the word of God, America has been more than blessed through its initial years. I believe that America has become like the prodigal son. We had everything that the Father had to give, and yet we wanted what we wanted. Our selfish desires have caused us to look to everything else except Him. This happened to Israel multiple times. But the LORD is not finished with Israel. His formula for restoration is found in 2 Chron. 7:14 and I believe it is also the truth for us as well. "If My people, who are called by My name, will humble themselves and pray and seek My face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land."

Dear LORD, please forgive us for being such a selfish lot. We have turned to our own ways and our own desires instead for looking to You for everything that we need. Help us to not just ask You to bless us, but instead help us to bless You. In Jesus Name, Amen.
