Isa. 43:11, "I, even I, Am the LORD, and besides Me there is no Savior."

The LORD makes an emphatic statement in today's scripture. He uses the same phraseology as He did when Moses questioned Him about who he should tell Pharaoh sent him. The LORD replied to Moses, tell him I AM has sent me to you. When the LORD says this, it is an emphatic statement the He and He alone is Who He says He is, and will always be. And then He makes the most important statement for mankind, *besides Me there is no Savior*. The Hebrew word for *Savior* is **movshia** which means *one who brings salvation, deliverer, one who gains victory and preserves*.

The second emphatic statement is this: the LORD is the only One Who can save. There is no hope in science, economy, healthcare, philosophy, or any other thing. They will all fail to meet the need in our lives. I'm amazed how many people look to their horoscope, the stock market, their relationships, or a thousand other things; thinking that they will find peace and satisfaction in those things. Peace is never found in a "thing" but in a person; the LORD. Everything in this world will come up short; will fail; will not satisfy. There is only One Who can save, deliver, preserve and defeat the enemy.

If you find yourself looking to anything else for your peace and happiness, you will be greatly disappointed. Our hope; our salvation is found in no one else except in Jesus Christ the LORD. He is all that matters.

Dear LORD, You and You alone are our salvation. We have no one else to turn to but You LORD. You are our hope, our peace, and our salvation. We turn to You for everything that we need. In Jesus Name, Amen.
