Ps. 110:5-7, "The LORD is at your right hand; He will crush kings on the day of His wrath. He will judge the nations, heaping up the dead and crushing the rulers of the whole earth. He will drink from a brook along the way, and so He will lift His head high." (NIV)

What an accomplishment by a rare few teams and individuals: The 1972 Miami Dolphins; The 1972 & 1973 UCLA Bruins Men's basketball team; The 2012 Baylor Lady Bears; Cael Sanderson (the only wrestler in NCAA Division I history to go undefeated with more than 100 wins. Needless to say, it is rare air in the stratosphere that these teams and athletes performed. But, I have one better than that. And so did King David as he sings about the One Who was and forever will be UNDEFEATED. His name is the LORD.

He is the champion, not only of the world, but of all creation. David mentions the day of His wrath. There will come a day when the wrath of God, that has been held back for so long, will be unleashed. He will judge. He will crush. He will finally unleash His mighty power for all to see. The fear of the LORD will become evident.

In the last portion of this passage, it makes a reference of drinking from a brook and lifting His head high. This could be an allusion to the three hundred men of Gideon, who did not get on their knees and drink from the water, but instead, stayed vigilant and kept their heads up to see what was happening around them. Our LORD is ever watching and knows all things that are happening. His head will always be lifted high!
