**Ps. 34:8, “Taste and see that the LORD is good; blessed is the one who takes refuge in Him.” (NIV)**

David is stating that the way to taste or see the LORD’s goodness is by faith. You will never know what something tastes like until you try it. Neither will you know what something looks like until you look at it. Many people judge the merit of the LORD without trying Him.
