The Lord wants you to experience real and abundant life:

Isa. 25:1 LORD, You are my God; I will exalt You and praise Your name, for in perfect faithfulness You have done wonderful things, things planned long ago. (NIV)

The LORD is Lord over everything. Make no mistake, He is in absolute control. But the question is really, is He your God? Is He your LORD? Isaiah exclaims, LORD, You are my God. This is a testimony coming from the lips and heart of one who had experienced the holiness of God. He had been in the LORD's presence and seen the glory of His majesty. Isa. 6:1-5 In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the LORD, high and exalted, seated on a throne; and the train of His robe filled the temple. Above Him were seraphim, each with six wings: with two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying. And they were calling to one another: "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD Almighty; the whole earth is full of His glory." At the sound of their voices the doorposts and the thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke. "Woe to me!" I cried. "I am a man of unclean lips, and live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the LORD Almighty." (NIV) There was no doubt in what Isaiah was able to see and experience. It was the fullness of the LORD in His glory. What a sight that must have been for him. It set the path for his ministry and he would continually gave praise to the Holy One. Once you have been given access into the throne room, nothing will ever be the same. But the one thing that changed more than anything in Isaiah's life was his obedience to the LORD. "Here am I, send me."

The LORD is looking for people, willing people, who will go forth in His name and fulfill His plan. Are you available? Are you willing? 2 Cor. 6:2 For He says, "In the time of My favor I heard you, and in the day of salvation I helped you." I tell you, now is the time of God's favor, now is the day of salvation. (NIV)

Dear LORD, help us to see You like You really are. Draw us into Your presence and we will never be the same. Help us to say, "here am I, Lord send me." In Jesus Name, Amen
