The Lord wants you to experience real and abundant life:

John 15:13-15 Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends. You are My friends if you do what I command. I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from My Father I have made known to you. (NIV)

Dear LORD, help us to keep our eyes on You. You are all that we really need. And as we seek You first, all the other things shall be added to us as well. In Jesus Name, Amen
