The Lord wants you to experience real and abundant life:

Rom. 8:38-39 *For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.* (NIV)

Oh, the blessed assurance of this thought. Absolutely nothing can separate us from the love of God. Just meditate for a few minutes on this incredible promise. When we die, we will be in His love. When we live, we will be in His love. When we face spiritual forces, we will be in His love. We have always been in His love, and we will always be in His love. He will never, ever stop loving you. He has always loved you and He always will. You can't disappoint Him enough that He will turn His back on you. You can't sin so bad that He will give up on you. His heart is full of love for you, and He watches over you, sings over you, takes care of you, leads you. His whole being is full of love for you. And Paul reiterates that there is nothing and no one that can change this!

Dear LORD, thank You that I can never fall out of Your love. You have always loved me, and You always will. I can't do anything to cause that to ever change; nor can anything else. Thank You for Your absolute, unconditional love. This allows me to live with abundance in a world that needs to know Your love. Help me to show that love to others. In Jesus Name, Amen
