This day the LORD will hand you over to me, and I'll strike you down and cut off your head." (NIV) And you know what? He did! What could a mere mortal do to someone who is being protected by the LORD Almighty? Absolutely nothing! We can live our lives in fear, or we can life an abundant life that is given and covered by the LORD Himself. I don't know what you will do, but as Joshua once proclaimed, "as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD!"
