John 1:12 Yet to all who did receive Him, to those who believed in His name, He gave the right to become children of God. (NIV)

Many years ago, **Amy Grant** wrote a song entitled "My Father's Eyes." The chorus says:

She's got her Father's eyes, her Father's eyes, Eyes that find the good in things when good is not around Eyes that find the source of help when help just can't be found Eyes full of compassion, seeing every pain, Knowing what you're going through, and feeling it the same, Just like My Father's eyes
