The Lord wants you to experience real and abundant life:

Ps. 16:11 You make known to me the path of life; You will fill me with joy in Your presence, with eternal pleasures at Your right hand. (NIV)

David makes an interesting assessment here when he mentions the *path of life*. He is looking forward to the only One Who can give real life. For centuries, the Hebrew people had been looking for the Messiah to come. Even at this point, David knew that the LORD would keep His covenant with His children. And it gives us the hope of eternal pleasures at His right hand. The right hand is the action hand of the Father and He will act. He will give. He will move. He will bless.
