He not only knows these things, He cares. He really does. Some might say, 'if God really cares, why does He let these things happen?' Because He makes sure that all things will ultimately remind people that He is God! And so David, once a young shepherd boy taking care of the family sheep, is now elevated to King of Israel. Did they have enemies? Oh yes they did! And they still do! Would Israel be attacked? Of course they would. But herein lies a beautiful picture of trust. David knew that no matter how big the giant; how great the nation that would rise up against them; that His God is LORD! He causes the sun to rise and set. He gives life to every creature. Not one little animal is born without His knowledge. Not one leaf falls from a tree that He does not see it. So what should that compel us to do? I will give thanks to You, LORD, with all my heart; I will tell of all Your wonderful deeds. I will be glad and rejoice in You; I will sing the praises of Your name, O Most High.
