The Lord wants you to live in His liberty and freedom.

1 Cor. 16:14 Do everything in love. (NIV)

Now this might seem like a no-brainer, but there is much more to be seen by this declaration. Let's break it down into manageable bites. First of all, we must *do* everything in love. We can't just think about it, hoping that it will happen. We are to love others just as the LORD loves us. That means unconditionally and completely. You might be thinking, there are some people that are very difficult to love. Guess what, so are we sometimes, even in the LORD's eyes. Lastly, we must do everything '*in love*.' This is the outward act of what is happening inside of us. Are we speaking with the motivation of love? Are we caring with His love as the engine? Are we desiring to fulfill God's love in our speech and actions? We must be the picture and the portrayal of the wonderful love of God. Let everyone see Him in you.

The outcome of this will be more powerful than anything else we can do. We must love people to Him. We must show them that He really cares. We must move over so that He can love through us. What would happen if the church of God showed the love of God? I believe it would be supernatural!
