The Lord wants you to live in His liberty and freedom.

Acts 2:28 You have made known to me the paths of life; You will fill me with joy in Your presence. (NIV)

Let's follow His Word today and be filled with His joy, so that others might sense that joy and want to know the One Who gives it.
