The Lord wants you to live in His liberty and freedom:

Ps. 91:1-2 Whoever dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in Whom I trust. (NIV)

Did you know that the LORD has a secret shelter for His children? It is a place to live and rest in Him. Here there is no judgment or strife, just the sweet peace of Christ. El Shaddai means the All-Sufficient God. A literal translation is God, the Mountain One; the strong and unchanging One; the Most High. To live in His shadow means that we are 'covered' by His presence. There is no better place to be than to bask in the presence of the Almighty One. Here we can find safety and grace and protection and provision. In His shadow means we are walking and abiding in Him. Let's dwell in the shelter of the Most High today. There is no better place to be!
