Ps. 34:8 Taste and see that the LORD is good; blessed is the one who takes refuge in Him. (NIV)

I remember as a young boy an old commercial that came on TV. It was sponsored by Alka-Seltzer. The main point was the phrase, 'Try it, you'll like it.' In a sense, that is the admonition of David in today's verse. I remember my grandma loved boiled okra. It looked so gross and slimy to a young boy like me, I just couldn't bring myself to taste it.
