The Lord wants you to live in His liberty and freedom.

Ps. 33:4-5 For the word of the LORD is right and true; He is faithful in all He does. The LORD loves righteousness and justice; the earth is full of His unfailing love. (NIV)

This passage is a statement of the character of our LORD. I'm so grateful that I can trust the word of God. If I have a need, it is there. If I have a question, the answer is there. When I am struggling for direction, His word guides me. And, we see in this passage that the 'word' of God and the 'work' of God are inseparable. What He says, He will do. At that moment I just thought about how loving our Father is and amazing in all that He does. He is a good, good Father.

Dear Father, You are perfect in every way. Your word is truth. You are faithful in all of Your ways. This whole world is full of Your love that will never fail. Thank You LORD. In Jesus Name, Amen
