The Lord wants you to live in His liberty and freedom.

1 Tim. 6:18-19 Command them to do good, to be rich in good deeds, and to be generous and willing to share. In this way they will lay up treasure for themselves as a firm foundation for the coming age, so that they may take hold of the life that is truly life. (NIV)

I love this statement from Paul to Timothy. As he is mentoring his young disciple, he is making sure to give him good and constructive help in the ministry. He is sharing with him what he should be helping his congregation to do. The overarching thought is to be 'givers' and not 'takers.' That will bode well for us as well.
