## Because God loves you, He Provides- Part 59

Did you know that God loves you more than anyone else could ever love you?

God proves His love to you by providing **His trust** to you. **1 Cor. 13:7**, "It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres."

The Greek word for **trusts** is *pisteuei* which means to believe enough to have confidence. The kind of love God has for us gives us the ability to walk by faith; to trust that His love will always be with us and never fail us. It literally means that God guarantees that He will always love you. I dare say that many of us have "trust" issues. We've been fooled too many times by those who would say one thing and then do another. The whole advertising business is built on trying to get you to believe and trust that what they are promoting is true, reliable and trustworthy. Let me tell you my friend, that there is nothing in this whole universe that is more trustworthy than this: God loves you. You can believe it; you can trust it; you can stand upon it!

Have you ever been in a situation that you had to trust that what you were stepping on would hold you up? At first, you might test it with one foot while holding onto something else. As a child, there was an old board that crossed a deep ditch. I was afraid to try to cross because the board would sway and creak as you would put your weight on it. Finally, I just decided to let go of the tree next to it and walk across; and it held me up. Paul is stating in this passage that God's love is something that you can always trust and put your faith in. It will never let you down. Eventually, other things will crumble and fail, but not the love of God. His love never fails. You can trust it because you can trust Him! In Psalm 136, the psalmist ends each verse with *His love endures forever*. And, that is because God is never going to stop loving you.

Dear Father, thank You that we can always trust that Your love will always be there for us. Thank You that Your love never fails. We can look to You and trust that You will always be there for us. Thank You! In Jesus Name, Amen
