Because God loves you, He Provides- Part 176

Did you know that God loves you more than anyone else could ever love you?

God proves His love to you by **His revealing love. Rom. 1:17, “For in the gospel the righteousness of God is revealed—a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: “The righteous will live by faith.”**

The Greek word for *revealed* is **apokaluptetai** which means *to uncover, reveal, and make known*. God’s purpose for every person in this world is that they can know His great love which is revealed in the gospel of Jesus Christ. This is the gospel that He has made known and has made us His ambassadors as though He was making His appeal through us. Yesterday, we looked at His covering of our sins by the atonement of the blood of Jesus. Today, He is now encouraging us by His revelation of this gospel. This is for anyone who will believe by faith. And since He has revealed this to us, He is now giving us the commission to go and tell all people of this amazing love.

So, how do we live by faith? We live it for Him and for His gospel. Our priority must be, as Paul stated, ***to live is Christ and to die is gain***. Don’t you wonder what would happen if we all made it our top priority in life to share the gospel?

Rom. 10:14-15, “How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the One of Whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: “How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!”
