Trinity Love

2 Cor. 13:14 May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.

I love how the trinity of God shows up. Over and over in scripture we see the manifestation of our God, three in one. Paul makes reference to this in this passage today and it has such great significance for us all.

1. We get grace from the Lord Jesus Christ. I love the acronym: God's, Riches, At, Christ's, Expense. Now why would Jesus give us grace? Because of His great love for us. Why would He take our sins upon Himself and pay our sin debt on the cross? Because of His great love for us. Why is He now ever interceding for us in Heaven? Because of His great love for us. Why is He coming again to take us to be with Him as His bride? Because of His great love for us.

2. We get fellowship from the Holy Spirit. The paraclete comes to do what His name says; to walk alongside us and encourage us. Why? Because of His great love for us. The word fellowship reminds me of the illustration: two fellows in one ship; they work together if they want to get somewhere. 2 Cor. 5:14a For Christ's love compels us; therefore it is His love that is the power that moves us forward as we work in union with Him.

3. We get agape love from the Father. His love is unconditional, pure, and everlasting. God is love: steadfast and unchanging, comforting, motivating, and eternal. You will never have to wonder if God loves you because love is Who He is. Can I just say this; God loves YOU! He loves YOU! He loves YOU! He will never stop loving you! He will always love you! Dear Father, thank You for the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ. Thank You for the fellowship of the Holy Spirit. Thank You for Your amazing love! Thank You! Thank You! Thank You! In Jesus Name, Amen
