The Gifts Of Christ: We have <u>wisdom</u> from God.

James 1:5 If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, Who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you. (NIV)

True wisdom is something you can only get from God. There is no way to obtain wisdom on your own. Wisdom is seeing things from God's perspective. Since our LORD knows everything; since He's the maker of all things; it just makes sense that He is the only source of true wisdom.

Wisdom is not only the knowledge about something, but then the ability to use that knowledge in accordance with God's plan and purpose. I have known many people who were very intelligent and knew great amounts of facts who had very little wisdom. It reminds me of our Lord's teaching in Mk. 8:34-36 Then He called the crowd to Him along with His disciples and said: "Whoever wants to be My disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow Me. For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for Me and for the gospel will save it. What good is it for someone to gain the whole world, yet forfeit their soul? (NIV) How many have looked to this world and its riches to fulfill or complete them, but it never could.

Dear LORD, help us to look to You because You are the giver of all good things. You are the holder of all wisdom. Help us to look to You alone because You alone are wise. You hold all wisdom in Your hands. In Jesus Name, Amen
