Heb. 7:25 Therefore, He is able to save completely those who come to God through Him, because He always lives to intercede for them. (NIV)

In the days before Jesus came to pay for our salvation through His death on the cross, the system for God's people was through the priests, particularly the High Priest. It was his yearly pilgrimage into the Holy of Holies, where he would carry the blood of the spotless lamb and sprinkle it on the cover of the Ark of the Covenant known as the Mercy Seat. But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. (NIV) It is because of His great love for us. And so now Jesus stands as our mediator; our High Priest. Rom. 8:33-34 Who will bring any charge against those whom God has chosen? It is God Who justifies. Who then is the one who condemns? No one. Christ Jesus Who died - more than that, Who was raised to life - is at the right hand of God and is also interceding for us. (NIV) I have to admit that as I meditated on this, that He would even now be praying for me, I broke into sobs and knew that I certainly didn't deserve the price that He paid for me. But He did it anyway. 1 John 3:1 See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are! (NIV)
